Shepherds Who Feed Themselves Ezekiel 34

Let's learn about the expectations God has for those who lead His people!



- *Shepherd" Hebrew: "Raah" -Pronounced - Raw-aw
 - o Figuratively To rule, feed, pasture.
- *Shepherd" Greek: "Poimaino"
 Pronounced poy-mah-ee-no
 - o Figuratively To rule, feed, tend.



- o (Vs 1-2) Who were the shepherds of Israel?
 - o Priests, Levites
- Problem Identified: The priests and levites are feeding themselves, rather than tending the sheep.
- (Vs 3) The shepherds are enjoying abundance, while the sheep starve.

"Woe to the shepherds of Israel who feed themselves! should not the shepherds feed the flocks?" Ezekiel 34:2

- e (Vs 4) Accusations against the Shepherds!
 - o They have not strengthened the weak.
 - o They have not heated the sick.
 - They have not bound up the broken or sought the lost.
 - o They have ruled with force and cruelly.

"The weak you have not strengthened, nor have you heated those who were sick, nor bound up the broken, nor brought back what was driven away, nor sought what was lost; but with force and cruelly you have ruled them." (Ezekiel 34:4)

- e (Vs 4) Accusations against the Shepherds!
 - e They have not strengthened the weak.
 - o They have not heated the sick.
 - They have not bound up the broken or sought the lost.
 - o They have ruled with force and cruelty.

 - o (Vs 5) The flock is scallered.
 - o (Vs 19) The flock is malnourished.
 - o (Vs 22) The flock is unprotected.

- o God explains the way He shepherds.
 - @ (Vs 15) God feeds the flock.
 - Ø (Vs 16) God seeks the Lost, binds the broken, and strengthens the sick.
- o God will set up the Chief Shepherd
 - "My servant David" David is long dead, must refer to Jesus. (1 Peter 5:4).

God has a genuine concern for the safety and health of the flock. He prioritizes acting on it.

shepherds who feed themselves

- (Vs 30-31) The shepherds, the sheep, and the pasture all belong to God!
- The Chief Shepherd, Jesus, works tirelessly to provide for the flocks.

The shepherd's job is so important because they have been delegated part of Jesus' job.

Let's learn about the expectations God has for His "royal priesthood"



- o "Priests" Hebrew: Kohen pronounced: Ko-hane
 - o "Officiant although a Layman."
- * Priesthood" Greek: hierateuma pronounced: hee-er-at-yoo-mah
 - officiants. (1 Peter 2:9)



- (Vs 2) God is bringing a curse on the levitical priests, descendants of Levi.
- (Vs 4-6) God's covenant with Levi was good, but the priests have corrupted it.

"My covenant was with him, one of life and peace, And I gave them to him that he might fear Me; so he feared Me and was reverent before My name."

- Rather, the priests should be acting out God's will and glorifying Him.
